Before You Start

Basic Stitches you will need in this pattern





Project 2

It's a month of texture! This month we're working with the Even Berry stitch and creating a scarf to match our beanie from project 1. This project may be a bit simpler as we're only working in rows, but it is a much bigger project to contend with.

Materials

- Any 4 ply yarn – approx. 1100m. I used a 4ply Lola.
- 3.5mm hook
- Needle to weave in ends

Gauge

Not critical

Measurements

36cm x 134cm

Pattern Notes:

This pattern is totally adjustable.

You can make it in any yarn, any width and any length.

If you don't like to make a chain to begin, you might want to work the width instead of the length. Using a lola my preference is to have the short ends be the same colour.

If you're adjusting, just make sure you have an even number of chains.

Don't stress if you get the stitch count wrong, just add an extra single crochet (UK double crochet) to the end so that you always finish with a single crochet.

You might want to consider adding tassles or a fringe to the ends.

The turning chain does not count as a stitch.



PATTERN- US TERMS:

BASIC STITCHES:

Slip Stitch: Insert your hook into the stitch. YO and pull the yarn through the stitch the continue to pull through the loop on your hook.

Chain: YO and pull the yarn through the loop on your hook.

Single Crochet: Insert your hook into the stitch. YO and pull the yarn through the stitch to pull up a loop. You will have 2 loops on your hook. YO, pull through both loops on your hook.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Berry Stitch: Yarn over and insert your hook into the stitch or space indicated. Yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on your hook. You will have 3 loops on your hook. Yarn over and insert your hook into the same stitch or space indicated. Yarn over and pull up a loop. You will have 5 loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull through all 5 loops.

PATTERN

ROW	INSTRUCTION
Begin	Chain 260. Or to desired width if working the width. Or to desired length if you want a shorter or longer scarf.
Row 1.	1sc in the second chain from the hook. One single crochet in each chain to the end. Chain 1 and turn (259)
Row 2.	Ch1, 1sc in into the first stitch <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1BERRY into the next stitch• 1sc into the next stitch.• Repeat the stitches in bold – finishing with a single crochet• Chain 1 and turn
Row 3.	Ch1, 1 sc into each stitch. Chain 1 and turn.
Row 4-XX	Repeat rows 2 and 3 until desired length/width is achieved. Fasten off. Add a fringe to the end if preferred.

PATTERN - UK TERMS

Basic Stitches (UK Terms):

Slip Stitch: Insert your hook into the stitch. YO and pull the yarn through the stitch the continue to pull through the loop on your hook.

Chain: YO and pull the yarn through the loop on your hook.

Double Crochet: Insert your hook into the stitch. YO and pull the yarn through the stitch to pull up a loop. You will have 2 loops on your hook. YO, pull through both loops on your hook.



Special Stitches:

Berry Stitch: Yarn over and insert your hook into the stitch or space indicated. Yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through the first loop on your hook. You will have 3 loops on your hook. Yarn over and insert your hook into the same stitch or space indicated. Yarn over and pull up a loop. You will have 5 loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull through all 5 loops.

Pattern

ROUND	INSTRUCTION
Begin	Chain 260. Or to desired width if working the width. Or to desired length if you want a shorter or longer scarf.
Row 1.	1sc in the second chain from the hook. One single crochet in each chain to the end. Chain 1 and turn (259)
Row 2.	Ch1, 1sc in into the first stitch <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1BERRY into the next stitch• 1sc into the next stitch.• Repeat the stitches in bold – finishing with a single crochet• Chain 1 and turn
Row 3.	Ch1, 1 sc into each stitch. Chain 1 and turn.
Row 4-69	Repeat rows 2 and 3 until desired length/width is achieved. Fasten off. Add a fringe to the end if preferred.
